I write to confirm our conversation that the United States is willing to withdraw the Civil Investigative Demands issued following its Notice of No Decision to avoid necessitating the Court's involvement in this discovery dispute. Specifically, the United States has agreed to withdraw 18-13-EDKY, 18-02-EDKY, 18-03-EDKY, 18-20-EDKY (issued to Victoria Sain), and 18-21-EDKY (issued to Bryan Harmon).

Because this agreement moots the dispute, you have agreed to voluntarily withdraw your petition and dismiss the miscellaneous action seeking to set aside the CIDs. Because the hearing is set for this afternoon, would you mind sending a courtesy copy to the Court once you've filed it and cc us, to ensure that Chambers is aware we've reached an agreement?
